It is to state that Dr. S.K. Datta, Secretary, Animal Welfare Board of India, Ballabgarh, Haryana in his letter cited in the 1<sup>st</sup> reference requested Action Taken Report on illegal catching of stray dogs and cruelty to animals in Butchireddipalem of SPS Nellore District for taking further necessary action.

The same was endorsed to SDPO, Nellore Rural with a request to enquire the matter and take immediate necessary action and sent the action taken report. Accordingly as per the instructions of SDPO, Nellore Rural, CI, Butchireddipalem enquired the matter and submitted his detailed report along with connected documents to SDPO, Nellore Rural who in-turn submitted the same to this office along with his remarks cited in the 2<sup>nd</sup> reference.

The enquiry reveals that due to lock down in view of Covid-19 there was no food to stray dogs on Bombay Highway and streets in Butchireddipalem village on that as per the advice of the Commissioner, Nagar Panchayat, Butchireddipalem, trained persons of (municipal workers) who had skills to catch the stray dogs, caught hold the stray dogs without sustaining any injuries and left the same in the neighboring colonies by providing food by conducting awareness programmes in Municipal area including main road. After some days when the shops and hotels were

opened and running they left the said stray dogs in the same area. In this regard in reply to ROC.No.12062/1/2020-M3, Dt.27.10.2020 of Commissioner & Director of Municipal Administration, A.P. Guntur, the Commissioner, Butchireddipalem Nagara Panchayat submitted a detailed report Dt.12.11.2020 marking copies to all concerned that Nagar Panchayat officials have never committed any unambiguous crime or cruelty on stray dogs. The report of CI, Butchireddipalem is enclosed herewith for kind perusal.

Under the above circumstances, Nagar Panchayat officials have never committed any unambiguous crime or cruelty on stray dogs, hence no further action is need on the 1<sup>st</sup> reference and the same may please be lodged.

**Sub:-** Police - Buchireddypalem Circle - SPSR Nellore District - AP State - Submission of reply to the Letter of Sri.Dr.S.K.Dutta, Secretary, Animal Welfare Board of India, Ballabgarh, Haryana regarding illegal catching of stray dogs and cruelty to animals- Regarding.

With reference to the above, I submit that Sri.Dr.S.K.Dutta, Secretary, Animal Welfare Board of India, Ballabgarh, Haryana sent a letter to the Supdt. of Police, SPSR Nellore District regarding illegal catching of stray dogs and cruelty to animals in Buchireddypalem Nagar Panchayat, Municipal Commissioner at Nellore (A.P), field by Blue Cross members, Guntur through E.Mail on 21.10.2020 about illegal catching and torturing of stray dogs in Nellore District, A.P. in violation of the provisions of prevention of cruelty to Animals Act-1960 and its Rules and violation of the directions of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India. The authorities are promoting the organized crimes in their respective jurisdictions by engaging the official staff, workers and outsourced personnel along with unauthorized persons to the illegitimate activities to capture the street dogs in cruel and inhumane manner and transported illegally to faraway places. The gruesome incident that took place in Buchireddypalem jurisdiction on 15, 16, 17 October, 2020. Hence requesting to initiate stringent actions on the concerned officials in this matter.

In this regard, having left my office, visited Buchireddypalem Nagara panchayat secured Sri.Vuyyala Srinivasarao s/o Lt. Venkateswarlu, age 49yrs, commissioner, Nagara Panchayat, Buchireddypalem, examined him and recorded his statement.

As per the version of the Nagar Panchayat commissioner, he is working as Commissioner, Nagar Panchayat, Buchireddypalem from 2.2.2020. As the shops and hotels were closed on Bombay highway and streets in Buchireddypalem due to lock down regarding Covid-19, the stray dogs have no food, on his advice the municipal workers Vannam Hari, Vadlamudi Srinu and



Patra Vijay, who had skill to catch the stray dogs, caught hold the stray dogs without sustaining any injuries and left in the neighboring colony by provided food to said dogs. After some days, while the shops and hotels were opened and running they left said dogs in the same area without any cruelty.

In this regard I have collected a copy of letter, which he submitted to the Commissioner @ Director of Municipal Administration, Guntur.

Then I have secured 1) Vannam Hari s/o Narayana, age 31yrs, madiga by caste, Pedduru, Buchireddypalem, Nagar Panchayat employee. (6301540775), 2) Patra Vijay s/o Marathi, age 29yrs, madiga, Pedduru, Buchireddypalem, Nagar Panchayat sweeper. (9100484763), 3) Vadlapudi Srinu s/o Narayana, age 26yrs, madiga, Pedduru, Buchireddypalem, Nagar Panchayat sweeper. (985389472) at my Office, Buchireddypalem, examined them and recorded their statements in detailed.

As per the version of 1) Vannam Hari, 2) Patra Vijay and 3) Vadlapudi Srinu, all of they are working as sweepers in Buchireddypalem Nagara Panchayat on contract basis for Rs.8,500/- per month. They are the skilled workers to catch the stray dogs. As the shops and hotels were closed in Buchiureddypalem due to lock down regarding Covid-19, the stray dogs have no food. On the advice of their Municipal commissioner, they caught the stray dogs by carefully without sustaining any injuries to said dogs and shifted to the neighboring colony, kept them for some days by providing food and after some days, while the shops and hotels were opened and running they left said dogs in the same area without any cruelty. In this regard their Municipal Officers also conducted awareness programs regarding said stray dogs.

I have conducted confidential enquiries in the Buchiredypalem town and learnt that some street dogs were identified by the municipal officials in the main road area of Buchi Nagar Panchayat which wandering in the main road without food in the covid-19 pandemic time. In Covid-19 pandemic time food is not available to said stray dogs in that area due to the closing of various shops. In view of the above the municipal officials were caught hold said doges carefully and shifted them to adjustment colony and provided the food in that colony for few days. After control and containment of the Covid-19 pandemic in Buchi Nagar Panchayat, total shops were reopened in the above area. After opening the shops the same dogs were replaced in the same area. During the catching of the dogs, even one dog was not injured. Buchireddyapalem Nagar Panchayat officials were not shown any cruelty towards street dogs. Only trained persons have caught the above dogs carefully, during the shifting of dogs to adjustment colony for providing of food to them in the Covid-19 pandemic time. Number of awareness programs

conducted by the municipal commissioner to provide food for street dogs in the various colonies of Municipal area including main road in the covid-19 Pandemic time. In this regard it is established that the Nagar Panchayat officials have never committed any unambiguous crime or cruelty on stray dogs.

In the above circumstances, no need of further action in this petition.

In the reference 1<sup>st</sup> cited complaint filed by Sri Suresh Jagu, Founder Secretary, Blue Cross of Guntur, In the reference 2<sup>nd</sup> cited The Commissioner & Director of Municipal Administration, Andhra Pradesh, Guntur has instructed to the Municipal Commissioner to submit the detailed report immediately. In this connection I here with submit detailed report on the above complaint in Buchireddypalem Nagar Panchayat. Only some street dogs were identified by the Municipal Officials in the main road area of Buchireddypalem Nagar Panchayat. The above dogs were wandering in the main road with out food in the COVID-19 pandemic time.

In COVID-19 pandemic time food is not available to the above street dogs in that area due to the closing of Various Shops. In view of the above the municipal officials are catch the above dogs carefully and shifted the street dogs to the adjustment colony to provided the food in that colony, for few days. After Control and Containment of the COVID-19 Pandemic in Buchireddypalem Nagar Panachyat, total shops were reopened in the above area. After opening of the above shops the same dogs were replaced in the same area. During the catching of the above dogs even one dog was not injured. Buchireddypalem Nagar Panchayat Officials are not shown any cruelty towards street dogs. Only trained persons are caught the above dogs carefully during the shifting of above dogs to adjustment colony for the providing of food to the street dogs in the COVID-19 Pandemic time. Number of awareness programmers were conducted by the Municipal Commissioner, to provide food for street dogs in the various colonies of Municipal area including main road in the COVID-19 Pandemic time.

In Buchireddypalem Nagar Panchayat Municipal officials are never disrespectful towards their official duties and never misusing the designated Authoritative powers. The Buchireddypalem Nagar Panchayat Officials are never committed to unambiguous organised crime.
