**Sub: Alleged complaint regarding brutal killing of stray dog near
Ellaithotam Rd, Coimbatore- Reg**

Ref: Email dated 25.04.21 from Shri Mayur Hasija.

Sir,

With reference to the above cited subject, it is stated that the Board has received a complaint by Shri Mayur Hasija stated that a stray dog was killed by a person near Ellaithotam Road, Coimbatore. A copy of the report is forwarded for your kind perusal and further directions.

2. The Prevention of cruelty to Animals (PCA), Act, 1960 under Section 11(1)(l) stated that *"it is a cognizable offence, if any person mutilated any animals or kill any animals (including stray dogs) by using the method of strychnine injection in the heart or in any other unnecessarily cruel manner"*.

3. The Section 428 of the IPC deals with the punishment for committing mischief by killing, poisoning, maiming or rendering useless any animal or animals of the value of ten rupees or upwards, and the person shall be punished with the imprisonment of either description for term which may extend to two years, or with fine or with both.

4. The Hon'ble Supreme Court had directed to take action against the erring officials as per the Para 77 of the S.L.P.No.(C) 11686 of 2007, Animal Welfare Board of India Vs A.Nagaraja & Others and the department of Personnel and Training, Ministry of Personnel, Public Grievances and Pension had issued guidelines vide F.No.30/9/2006-Welfare dated 26.5.2006 to take action against such personnel violating the laws. The copies of the same is attached herewith for your information.

5. In view of the above, it is requested to conduct an enquiry on the above complaint and take action against the offenders as per law and forward a detailed report within 7 days from the receipt of this letter.
