Subject: Alleged complaint regarding the Brutally attacking a street dog with iron rod and trying to kill- Regarding

Ref.: Email dated 30.04.21 received from Ms. Rumpy Madaan.

Sir,

With reference to the above cited subject, it is stated that the Board has received a complaint from Ms. Rumpy Madaan from Bhathindi, Jammu stated that a Sardar man living opposite Nayi Delhi Resturant, Jammu has brutally stabbed a street dog with big iron rod and kept on dragging him. This man has a history of beating dogs, running his vehicle over sleeping dogs and trying to kill them. A copy of the complaint is attached here with for your reference.

2. The killing of animals is an offense under Section 11(1) of the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals Act, 1960, IPC 428 & 429, and violation of the directions of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India.

3. The Hon'ble Supreme Court had directed to take action against the erring officials as per the Para 77 of the S.L.P.No.(C) 11686 of 2007, Animal Welfare Board of India Vs A.Nagaraja & Others and the department of Personnel and Training, Ministry of Personnel, Public Grievances and Pension had issued guidelines vide F.No.30/9/2006-Welfare dated 26.5.2006 to take action against such personnel violating the laws. The copies of the same is attached herewith for your information.

4. In view of the above, it is requested to conduct an enquiry on the above complaint and take appropriate action against the offenders as per law and forward a detailed report within 7 days from the receipt of this letter.
