Sir,

The Animal Welfare Board of India has received a complaint from Shri Bharat Aggarwal from Stove Gali, Nera Satsang Bhawan mandir, Kishanpura, Saharanpur stating that in front of his house there are 4-5 pet dogs owned by a person (Vishav Kapoor) he leaves the dogs on his balcony on the front side of his house and they are creating nuisance all day and night. These dogs barking whole night. we are having infants which cries a lot on the barking of the dogs and senior citizens who are suffering from problem of insomnia. A copy of the complaint letter is attached herewith for your ready reference.

The Hon'ble Supreme Court has also issued interim orders dated 18.11.2015 & 9.3.2016 in SLP No.691 of 2009, AWBI Vs P.E.S.T & Ors directed all the local bodies to provide infrastructure as mandated in the ABC (Dogs) Rules, 2001 and implement the Rules diligently. It was specifically ordered that no innovative method or subterfuge should be adopted not to carry out the responsibility under the **PCA Act, 1960** or the **ABC (Dogs) Rules, 2001** and that any kind of laxity while carrying out statutory obligations, is not countenanced in law. The Board has also forwarded a module to all the State Govts. regarding the proper implementation of the ABC programme. The Board has issues several advisories and circulars regarding the guidelines for the Pet Dogs and Stray dogs and the same is attached.

In view of the above it is requested to direct the concerned authorities to take appropriate action as per law and forward a copy of the action taken report to the Board at the earliest.
