**Subject: Alleged complaint regarding illegal transportation of camels in Kadapa, Andhra Pradesh – Regarding**

**Sir,**

With reference to the above cited subject, it is brought to the notice of the Board by EQ South India stating that camels are continuing to be brought into Kadapa for slaughter purpose. However rescued only 19 camels out of 30. No efforts have been made to date to hunt down the culprits and rescue the remaining 11 camels. A copy of the complaint is enclosed which is self-explanatory.

2. It is Violation of the Transport of Animals Rules, 1978 and (Amended in 2001 & 2009), Section 3 and 11(1) of the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals Act, 1960. The Board had issued several advisories and circulars regarding the welfare of animals and the same is available in the website: [www.awbi.in](http://www.awbi.in)

3. The Hon'ble Supreme Court had directed to take action against the erring officials as per the Para 77 of the S.L.P.No.(C) 11686 of 2007, Animal Welfare Board of India Vs A.Nagaraja & Others and the department of Personnel and Training, Ministry of Personnel, Public Grievances and Pension had issued guidelines vide F.No.30/9/2006-Welfare dated 26.5.2006 to take action against such personnel violating the laws. The copies of the same is attached herewith for your information.

4. In view of the above, it is requested to direct the concerned authorities to take in this matter and take necessary action against the erring officials as per the law. A detailed report be forwarded to the Board for information and further necessary action.
