Subject: Alleged Complaint regarding the cruelty inflicted to cat in Patparganj, delhi- Regarding

Sir,

With reference to the above cited subject, it is brought to the notice of the Board by Shri Nabh Malik from Vijay Laxmi Housing Society at Patparganj, east Delhi stating that on 1st June, one of the male cats was missing and later found in the lawn hedge with extremely deteriorated condition. The cat was not able to walk and had no voice from mouth because both the fore legs were broken badly from the joints and injuries on his face. A complaint email is attached which is self-explanatory.


2. The cruelty to animals is an offense under Section 11(1) of the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals Act, 1960, Animal Birth Control (Dogs) Rules, 2001 and Section 428 & 429 of Indian Penal Code, 1860.

3. The Hon'ble Supreme Court had directed to take action against the erring officials as per the Para 77 of the S.L.P.No.(C) 11686 of 2007, Animal Welfare Board of India Vs A.Nagaraja & Others and the department of Personnel and Training, Ministry of Personnel, Public Grievances and Pension had issued guidelines vide F.No.30/9/2006-Welfare dated 26.5.2006 to take action against such personnel violating the laws. The copies of the same is attached herewith for your information.

4. In view of the above, it is requested to conduct an enquiry into the matter and take necessary action as per law against the offenders and forward a copy of the action taken report to the Board at the earliest.
