Subject: Alleged complaint regarding the negligence of Happy Pooches & Veterinary doctors in Noida (UP) – Reg

Ref: Email dated 25.06.21 received from Mrs. Ananya Arora.

Sir,

With reference to the above cited subject, it is stated that the Board has received a complaint by Mrs. Ananya Arora stating that the illegal boarding for dogs and the criminal and professional negligence by Veterinary doctor leading to the death of her very healthy dog. She already filed an e-FIR with number 056019/2021 in UP Police, against the pet boarding 'Happy Pooches' in Sector-108, Noida for professional and criminal negligence leading to poisoning and death of her beloved dog and against Dr. Diwakar Sharma at Panacea veterinary Clinic in Sector 52 and 117, Noida for professional negligence and unethical practice. A copy of the e-mail is attached, which is self-explanatory.


2. Cruelty to animals or Killing of animals is an offense under Section 11(1) of the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals Act, 1960.

3. The Hon'ble Supreme Court had directed to take action against the erring officials as per the Para 77 of the S.L.P.No.(C) 11686 of 2007, Animal Welfare Board of India Vs A.Nagaraja & Others and the department of Personnel and Training, Ministry of Personnel, Public Grievances and Pension had issued guidelines vide F.No.30/9/2006-Welfare dated 26.5.2006 to take action against such personnel violating the laws. The copies of the same is attached herewith for your information.

4. It is therefore requested to direct the concerned authorities to take appropriate action against as per law. A copy of the action taken report be forwarded to the Board within fifteen days from the receipt of this letter and to take immediate and necessary action to ensure that such cruelty to animals does not take place anywhere or at any time in future
