Subject: Request to take immediate action in regarding to the complaint related to dog biting and menace in the area of Sundar Nagar, Alambagh, Lucknow- Regarding

Sir,

With reference to the above cited subject, it is stated that the Board has received an email by Ms. Mnpreet Kaur Dubey from Sundar Nagar, Alambagh, Lucknow stating that there are more than 10 stray dogs, it is requested to these stray dogs sterilized and vaccinated at the earliest, which will help in ensuring welfare of stray dogs and also protecting the residents from any unwanted disease. A copy of the complaint is attached, which is self-explanatory.

2. In this regard it is stated that the Animal Birth Control (Dogs) Rules, 2001 notified by the Govt. of India directs the local body to form a monitoring committee which shall be responsible for the planning and management of dog control programme in accordance with the Rules. You are requested to inform us whether the said committee is established and is meeting at least once in every month to assess the progress made in ABC programme as prescribed in the ABC (Dogs) Amendment Rules, 2001 (as amended in 2010). Kindly ensure that the ABC programme is implemented as per the provisions of the above said Rules and the guidelines given in the AWBI module. The same is available in our website: www.awbi.in.

3. The Hon'ble Supreme Court had directed to take action against the erring officials as per the Para 77 of the S.L.P.No.(C) 11686 of 2007, Animal Welfare Board of India Vs A. Nagaraja & Others and the department of Personnel and Training, Ministry of Personnel, Public Grievances and Pension had issued guidelines vide F.No.30/9/2006-Welfare dated 26.5.2006 to take action against such personnel violating the laws. The copies of the same is attached herewith for your information.

4. Therefore, it is you are requested that conduct an inquiry on the above complaint and take appoprate neccesary action. Also, send an action taken report may be forwarded to the Board to take further necessary action.
