Sub: Alleged complaint regarding the cruelty against the Cows in Tabelas - Reg

Ref: Email dated 20.01.21 received from Ms. Nidhi Vats.

Sir,

With reference to the above cited subject, it is brought to the notice of the Board by Ms. Nidhi Vats stating that Mr. Rajesh Yadav, Krishna Chawl are operating illegal tabelas in Thakur Village Kandivali east, the said persons does not have any license to operate a tabela, they have large numbers of animals keeping in unhygienic conditions. This is an offense under Section 3, Section 11(1) of the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals Act, 1960 and Prevention of Cruelty to Animals (Cattle Premises) Rules, 1978. A copy of the email is attached which is self-explanatory.

The Supreme Court of India in a judgment dated 7.5.2014 in the matter titled AWBI Vs A.Nagaraja & Ors (SLP© No.11686 of 2007) has issued strong directions to all the agencies and instrumentalities of the State, including law enforcement authorities, to uphold animal right and protection laws. Failure to do so will be tantamount to contempt of the SC order as well. The Animal Welfare Board of India has forwarded the copy of the Supreme Court order dt.7.5.2014 to the Chief Secretary and Director General of Police of all States/U.T.s for information and to take necessary action to ensure that the directions of the Court are implemented in letter and spirit and the link is given here: http://www.awbi.org/awbi-pdf/sc_judgement_jallikattu_7-5-14.pdf

It is therefore requested to direct the concerned authorities to take appropriate action against the offenders as per law. A copy of the action taken report be forwarded to the Board within fifteen days from the receipt of this letter and to take immediate and necessary action to ensure that such cruelty to animals does not take place anywhere or at any time in future.

Kindly treat this as most urgent.
